SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION - 2024

We are pleased to announce that several scholarships will be available this year for eligible college students. The amounts vary, with no less than \$500 awarded.

ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicants (either men or women) must be a resident of the Klamath Basin and a graduate of a local high school or homeschool program. This includes all of Klamath County, Oregon, Tulelake and Butte Valley areas of Siskiyou and Modoc Counties, California.
2. Applicants attending a traditional college or university must be at least a sophomore (in their second year of college) when submitting the application. **High school students are not eligible.** Applicants attending specialized agriculture related programs must be currently enrolled. Graduate students or previous recipients **ARE** also eligible.
3. Applicants must have at least a cumulative GPA of 3.0.
4. Eligible students will be those who are **majoring in, or working toward a career that will benefit Agriculture.** This may include, but is not limited to: Large Animal Veterinary Medicine, Nutrition, Fabrication, Agri-business, Ag Communication, Ranch Management, Agronomy, Diesel Mechanics, Agri- Law, Ag Education, etc.

The scholarships are awarded on the basis of interests, future plans, activities, and an industry recommendation indicating that applicants show promise in their intended field.

Applications must be postmarked by **May 15, 2024.**
